

MEMORANDUM OF OPPOSITION

Senate Bill 528 (Senator Jackson) / Assembly Bill 1368 (Assemblyman Englebright)

RELATES TO THE RIGHT TO CLEAN AIR AND WATER AND A HEALTHFUL ENVIRONMENT

New York Farm Bureau, the state's largest general farm advocacy organization, urges you to oppose the above referenced legislation. This legislation would establish a "self-executing right" for each person to have clean air, clean water, and a healthful environment.

There already exists many environmental protections under the state and federal law. Adding this "selfexecuting right" without any corresponding legislation will only bring uncertainty and will not increase environmental protections. In the case of a self-executed right, a court would have to determine if a party had breached an individuals' right to a healthful environment and what constitutes a healthful environment. Currently, there are laws that impose criminal penalties on parties that harm the environment. The selfexecuting rights do not contain criminal penalties.

The New York State Constitution includes a Conservation Article that endeavors to protect the environment and other states have adopted an environmental bill of rights although only a few have incorporated selfexecuting rights. States that have these self-executing rights must define what is healthful and how to apply the rights when it came to court decisions. This legislation would only add unclear, ambiguous regulation and ultimately have a negative impact on a process that already enforces environmental protections.

For these reasons, New York Farm Bureau respectfully requests your opposition to this legislation.
